



How Alberta sugar beets and honeybees bring honey and canola oil to your family.

## Start with sugar beets and bees.

In the spring, the beekeeper feeds the bees a healthy sugar drink made from sugar beets. Now the bees are strong and ready to work.

The bees pollinate canola plants, which creates canola seed.

The bees collect nectar from the canola plants and turn it into honey.

Farmers plant the canola seed and grow lots more canola.

Each canola seed is filled with oil. A processor squeezes out the oil. That's the canola oil in your kitchen.

The beekeeper collects the honey. The honey goes in a jar or tub for people to enjoy.

In the fall, bees enjoy one final healthy sugar drink to help sustain them through the Alberta winter, until the following spring.

That's how sugar beets and honeybees work together to bring honey and canola oil to your family.
