



Fantasyland Hotel COVID-19 Update

The health and safety of our employees and guests is at the forefront of our post-COVID strategy. Fantasyland Hotel adheres to the COVID-19 policies and guidelines set out by the Government of Alberta and the City of Edmonton.

Face masks are now mandatory in all indoor public spaces effective Friday, September 3rd, 2021 as per **the City of Edmonton Temporary Mandatory Face Covering Bylaw**. This bylaw requires people to wear face coverings at all times while in indoor or enclosed public places.

Please be aware that the **Restriction Exemption Program** is in effect on Monday, September 20th, 2021 for restaurants and banquet/conference facilities within Fantasyland Hotel.

To enter, you must present:

1. Proof of vaccination
 - Single **vaccination** dose accepted between September 20th and October 25th if received 2 weeks before time of **visit**
 - Double **vaccination** doses required after October 25th
 - **For 18+**: Please verify name on Proof of Vaccination matches a valid Government Photo ID.
 - **Children 12 to 18**: Please verify name on Proof of Vaccination matches with any piece of supporting ID. (Alberta Healthcare Card, School ID, Passport, Birth Certificate, etc).
 - **Children under 12**: Do not need to provide proof of vaccination

OR

2. Proof of a privately paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of service.
 - **For 18+**: Please verify name on proof with valid Government Photo ID.
 - **Children 12 to 18**: Please verify name with any piece of supporting ID. (Alberta Healthcare Card, School ID, Passport, Birth Certificate, etc.)
 - **Children under 12**: Do not need to provide proof of negative PCR or Rapid Test.
 - Test from AHS or Alberta Precision Laboratories NOT allowed
 - Must Be Within 72 Hours of Service (Including duration of your visit)

Environmental Cleaning
