



## Resolution 7: Farm Safety **DEFEATED**

<b>TITLE OF RESOLUTION:</b>	
Farm Safety	
<b>RATIONALE / PURPOSE FOR RESOLUTION:</b>	
<p><b>Whereas:</b> Ag Safe Alberta has programs to increase awareness of farm safety hazards and provide safety training for farm owners and employees.</p> <p><b>Whereas:</b> farm owner/operators have an obligation to ensure a safe working environment for employees and family members.</p> <p><b>Whereas:</b> Ag safe Alberta can provide support to producers to develop Farm Safety programs</p>	
<b>BE IT RESOLVED THAT:</b>	
<p>In an effort to incentivise producers to participate in farm safety initiatives, producers who register with AgSafe Alberta and complete Farmers Care Level 1 prior to August 2023 will receive a discount of \$200 from their 2023 membership fee and hive levy invoice.</p> <p>ABC will work with AgSafe Alberta to provide free online farm safety training for registered producers.</p> <p>ABC will use The Alberta Bee News magazine to distribute farm safety information in cooperation with AgSafe Alberta.</p>	
<b>RESOLUTION BACKGROUND INFORMATION:</b>	
<p>Registering with AgSafe Alberta is free. Farmers Care Level 1 is an introductory course to farm safety hazard recognition, it is a free, self guided, easy to follow course that typically takes 1 hour to finish. If resolution is passed: an email with link to registration and instructions will be sent to eligible producers, this information will also be provided in an upcoming Bee News article.</p>
